



Herb 6- Pack Growing Tips

Cilantro - Rani

- I like full sun and well drained soil.
- Keep my soil evenly moist throughout the season.
- I prefer the cooler weather of the spring and fall.
- My leaves, stems and seeds are all useful.
- I am resistant to bolting.

Mint - Common

- I am a spreader, contain me or put me in a problem area in your yard.
- I am a perennial.
- I like full sun.
- Use me in your kitchen.
- I am very fragrant.

Oregano - Common

- Plant me in a pot or your garden.
- Keep my soil moist and well weeded.
- Harvest me often.
- I like full sun.
- Cut and dry me for a more pungent flavour.

Parsley - Italian Dark Green

- Plant me in a pot or your garden.
- I like loose, rich, well worked soil.

- I like full sun, but I need some protection from the afternoon heat.
- Pick off my flowers and use me often, so I continue to produce leaves.
- My stems are bitter, only use my leaves.

Tarragon

- I am a perennial herb that will be about 36" tall and 18" to 24" inches wide.
- I am easy to grow.
- I have a subtle anise or licorice flavour.
- I like full sun, but I can tolerate partial shade.
- Harvest my leaves throughout the season; use me fresh or dried.
- Trim me back regularly to prevent woodiness and encourage new growth
- Water me regularly while I am getting established in your garden.

Thyme - Winter German

- I'm a slow grower, but once established I am perennial.
- I can grow to be 8" tall.
- I like full sun and loose soil.
- Bees and other beneficial insects love me.
- Save and dry my harvest for year round use.
